
On behalf of the Education programs at the University of New Mexico – C(alN)/G), I request your support of \$100,000 as part to fe Tribal Education Initiatives in House Bill 2.

The Tribal Education Initiatives will enhance UNMG's ability to provide student services and instruction in the teacher education programs, including:

- UNM -COE Bacheldis program advisors and faculty;
- Administering PRAXIS tests on campus
- Instruction of lowerdivision teacher education and early childhood courses

Teacher vacancies in McKinley County and the surrounding area remain high. The UNMG student population is primarily Native American. The Tribal Education Initiatives funding at UNMG will provide course instruction and support services to help recruit, retain and graduate Native American students who will go on to fill the teaching vacancies in primarily Native American & Classrooms.

As the Yazzie Martinez case revealed, we have failed to provide a sufficient system of education New Mexico children, including Native Americar High teacher vacancies in McKinley County


UNM Gallup Campus Budget For FY 2022 - 2023

FY2022-2023 Instruction and General Sources of Revenue




FY2022-2023 Instruction and General Expenditures


